*She started her career as a pianist at 12 yrs old with performing Mozart Piano Concert (A dur) with Osaka Symphoniker Orchestra. After this brilliant debut, she won prizes at a lot of international and domestic piano competitions including Liszt-Bartok International Competition in 1999 and 2000 (Hungary), and International Minerbio Piano Competition in 2003 (Italy). As a soloist, she held many recitals at Budapest, Paris, Tokyo and Osaka. She also performed at various international music festivals such as International Bartok Seminar in Budapest, International Summer Academy in Salzburg (Austria), Nice (France), and Lenk (Switzerland). Recently, she cooperated into Japanese TV animation “Nodame Cantabile”, where all finger motions during piano playing were hers recorded by the motion-capture system. She graduated from Toho Gakuen in Tokyo, Franz Liszt Academy of Music in Budapest, Hungary (Dipl. piano & Dipl. chamber), and Conservatoire National de region-Pierre Barbizet Marseille in France (Dipl. piano). She studied with Profs. Rituko Nakayama, Keiko Takeuchi, Mayo Yoshimura, Andras Kemenes, and Bruno Rigutto. She also took master classes by Profs. Edith Picht-Axenfeld, Mikhail Voskresensky, Eva Poblocka, Bernard Ringeissen, Claude Helffer, and Karl-Heinz Kammerling.*
